## TumbleBooks – eBooks for Kids Electronic Resource

- (a) Describe how you play a TumbleBook. (b) What happens when you add it to a playlist?

(a) Once you have chosen a TumbleBook to view, click on the green “View Online” button in the menu to the left of the book cover. If the Tumblebook is a Storybook, it will play immediately after loading. If it is a Read-Along, you will need to press a play button after the book loads.

(b) When you add the book to a playlist, it is added to a list of books that play back to back so that you can have multiple books in a single “storytime session.”
- TumbleBooks offers stories in different languages. What languages are available?

English, French, Spanish, Chinese, and Russian.
- (a) How many books are available on TumbleBooks from popular author (and actor) John Lithgow? (b) How many of these books are narrated by John Lithgow?

(a) John Lithgow has five titles on Tumblebooks.

(b) He narrates two of them.
- (a) How many puzzles/games are available for Robert Munsch’s book, *The Paper Bag Princess*? (b) What are the different categories (types of games) for the puzzles and games section?

(a) There are three games available for *The Paper Bag Princess*.

(b) The different categories for Puzzles and Games are: Puzzles, Word Catch, Memory Game, Match the Sentence, Spelling, and Other.
- Please provide the Reading Level (Grade, Lexile, and Accelerated Reader) for the non-fiction title, *The Bumblebee Queen*.
