 - (b) There are articles relating to taxidermy in a variety of publications in this electronic resource. Try doing a search for "Taxidermy" in the Find Box.
 - (c) You'd find information about wine and wine making by following the Beer & Wine making link under the Home & Leisure Category. One of the publications in this electronic resource for wine aficionados is Quarterly Review of Wines.
- 3. I'm a stamp collector. (a) Are there any magazines with a publication date in late 2010 or early 2011 about this hobby? (b) If so, would you name them? (c) And under what category is my hobby listed?
 - (a) There are three magazines specifically on stamp collecting in this electronic resource.
 - (b) They are: *Canadian Philatelist, Mekeel's & Stamps Magazine,* and *U.S. Stamp News*. All of them have issues published between November 2010 and January 2011.
 - (c) Stamp collecting is found under the Collecting Category.
- 4. Name two of the four magazines in Hobbies and Crafts Reference Center that would be of specific interest to bird watchers?

Audubon, Birder's World, Bird Watcher's Digest, or South Dakota Bird Notes.

5. I need to do a craft and art project for my cub troop. A friend of mine who's a teacher tells me to look at *Arts & Activities*. Do you have this magazine? If so, do you have June 1990 issue?
